I have heard rumors that we are going backwards to 2007. At the time, I sent a complaint about it and refused to vote. Why? How on earth can I vote for people I do NOT know and never see or hear from.

Swords is the capital of Fingal and as I live in, it must remain united within the constituency of my Dublin Fingal. In 2007, a previous boundary commission made the crazy decision to divide Swords in two and a huge chunk of Swords (electoral division of Swords Forrest) was moved to the Constituency of Dublin West. This decision left thousands of voters disenfranchised and did nothing for democracy.
