Swords is the capital town of Fingal and must remain united within the constituency of Dublin Fingal. In 2007, a previous Boundary Commission made the crazy decision to divide Swords in two and a huge chunk of Swords (electoral division of Swords Forrest) was moved to the constituency of Dublin West. This decision left thousands of voters disenfranchised and did nothing for democracy.

In 2012 Swords, the capital town of Fingal was re-united in the new constituency of Dublin Fingal (that replaced Dublin North).

All of Swords, including the environs of Rolestown, Kilsallaghan and St. Margaret's (electoral divisions of Dubber and Kilsallaghan), is the capital town of Fingal and must remain united within the constituency of Dublin Fingal. Swords belongs in north County Dublin, not west Dublin.
