

With regard to the current Constituency Commission, please be advised that we believe that Rolestown, Kilsallaghan and St Margaret's (electoral divisions of Dubber

and Kilsallaghan) firmly belong in the constituency of Dublin Fingal along with all of Swords, our neighbouring town and the town we are most associated with.

We are closest to Swords, the capital town of Fingal and are represented at Council level by Councillors from Swords, Local Election Area. We were only recently re-united with Swords in the constituency of Dublin Fingal, having spent over 14 years in limbo as part of and on the outskirts of the constituency of Dublin West. We want to remain with Swords, in the constituency of Dublin Fingal and we do not want this positive decision from 2012 reversed. All of Swords, including the environs of Rolestown, Kilsallaghan and St Margaret's (electoral divisions of Dubber and Kilsallaghan) must remain united within the constituency of Dublin Fingal.

We belong with Swords in north County Dublin not west Dublin.
