

To whom it my concern,

Regarding the above areas, I wish to note that Swords is the capital town of Fingal and should remain united within the constituency of Dublin Fingal along with its neighbouring areas and townlands. Previous Boundary Commissions made poor and divisive decisions to divide Swords in two and a large part of Swords (electoral division of Swords Forrest) was moved to the constituency of Dublin West, along with the neighbouring rural agricultural environs, such as St. Margaret's, which are closely aligned and associated with Swords. This decision left thousands of voters disenfranchised and did nothing for democracy.

In 2012 we won our campaign to have the environs of Rolestown, Kilsallaghan and St. Margaret's (electoral divisions of Dubber and Kilsallaghan) correctly re-united back with all of Swords in the constituency of Dublin Fingal.

All of Swords, including the environs of Rolestown, Kilsallaghan and St. Margaret's (electoral divisions of Dubber and Kilsallaghan) should remain united within the constituency of Dublin Fingal. These areas, along with all of Swords, belong in north County Dublin, not west Dublin.
