

We wish to make a wish to make a submission relating to Cork South Central constituency. We would like to urge that the Crosshaven area be retained in the Cork South Central constituency rather than moved to Cork South West.

The reasons for this would be geographical and natural affinity. Crosshaven would no natural relationship with South West and the idea of the nearest local representative being in Bandon or Kinsale could lead to a huge sense of disenfranchisement for the population of the town, whereas Crosshaven and Carrigaline have long historic ties and current deep rooted social, economic and educational ties with large numbers of people commuting between the two towns every day and indeed residents of Crosshaven commuting to Cork for work, so the extent that the seaside town is now practically a suburb of the city.
